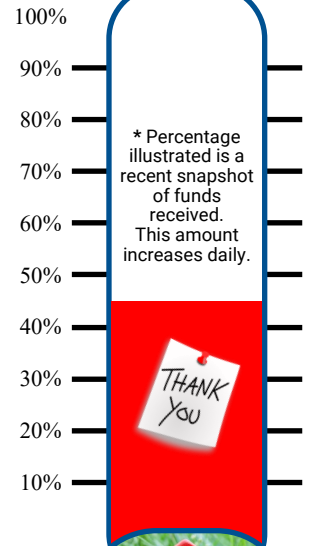

~ WHY GIVE? ~

40% of St. Clair County households are struggling with the basic cost of living. All programs we fund are designed to lift up our community and empower our residents to overcome obstacles and live more positive, self-sufficient lives. Our funding enables residents to receive the help they need through community services, regardless of their financial status.
