VISION

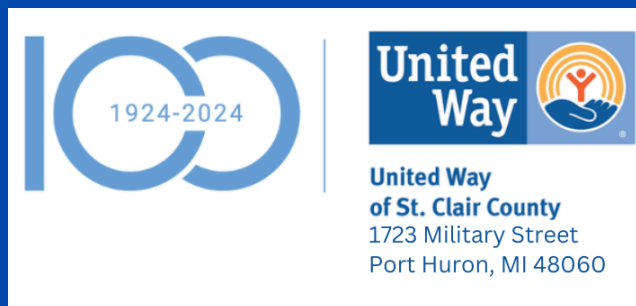
United Way of St. Clair County will be a leader to help the community identify and address human care problems. It will accomplish this by:
