Citizen's Review Committee Chair Report

The Citizens Review Committee (CRC) annually reviews proposals submitted by local affiliated organizations to reduce the need for emergency services, teach vouth life skills, improve quality of life through health and advocacy, and help adults through education and training. The members of the CRC engage in serious and thoughtful discussions when reviewing applications for funding. The CRC recommended that a total of 18 programs offered by 14 affiliated organizations be supported. While the need for direct support due to the pandemic has diminished, the community continues to be impacted by its aftermath. Health, shelter, and emergency services continue to be funding priorities. UWSCC, in collaboration with other community organizations, played an integral part in providing financial support to the temporary men's warming shelter that opened in January 2023. Other services UWSCC continues to support Michigan Vocational and Rehabilitation to facilitate employment, and the UW Emergency Fund for unique emergency requests. Amongst the affiliate and


