## LOCAL NEED

**ALICE:** Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed – households that earn above the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) but cannot afford the basic cost of living in their county. Despite struggling to make ends meet, ALICE households often do not qualify for public assistance.

- **41% of SCC residents are below the ALICE threshold. 26% of St. Clair County (SCC) households meet the ALICE threshold, and 15% are below the FPL.**
- **9,660 senior citizens of SCC meet the ALICE threshold and 2,814 are in poverty.**
- **In 2024, more than 570 SCC students were homeless.**
- **More than 25% of the adults in SCC had trouble meeting healthcare needs.**

## DONOR IMPACT

### Last year, donations impacted our neighbors by helping:

- 76 youth receive homeless, including shelter and street outreach supplies.
- 273 adults receive life-saving prescription assistance.
- 306 disabled youth & adults receive advocacy support to connect with available resources & resolve concerns.
- 357 men, women & children receive emergency shelter.
- 350 residents utilize substance use recovery resources.
