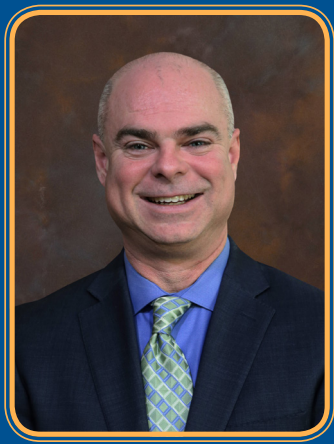

Citizen's Review Committee Chair Report

The Citizen's Review Committee (CRC) annually reviews proposals submitted by local affiliated organizations to reduce the need for emergency services, teach youth life skills, improve quality of life through health and advocacy, and help adults through education and training. There are over 20 members on the CRC.

Through this review process, the CRC recommended that 24 programs offered through 20 affiliated organizations be supported that include handicapped ramp construction, shelter for homeless and displaced adults, counseling, home health and hospice care, after school programming for youth and scouting. In addition, UWSCC directly supports 211 (call for help) services, Michigan Vocational and Rehabilitation to facilitate employment, transportation for the blind, and the UW Emergency Services Fund for unique emergency requests.

The CRC regularly reviews reports submitted by the organizations to assure that they have met local needs and that their program performance indicators have been fulfilled. A number of affiliated and non-affiliated organizations have attended CRC meetings in order to become better acquainted with the services they provide.

There are changes in social, health and economic needs that many individuals in St. Clair County face on a daily basis. The CRC reviews new organization requests, programs, and concepts to determine if and how these needs can be met.

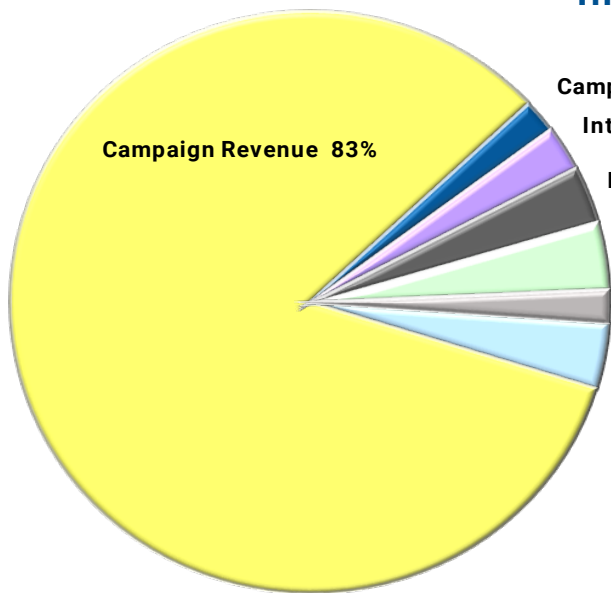

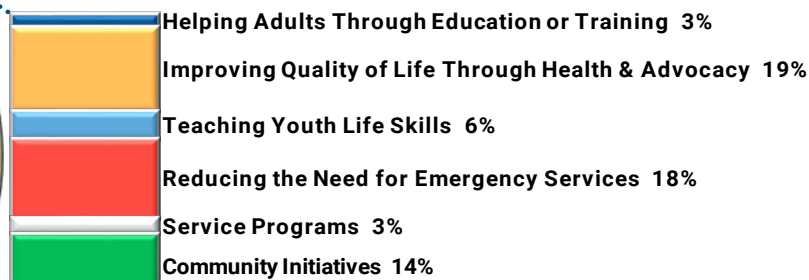
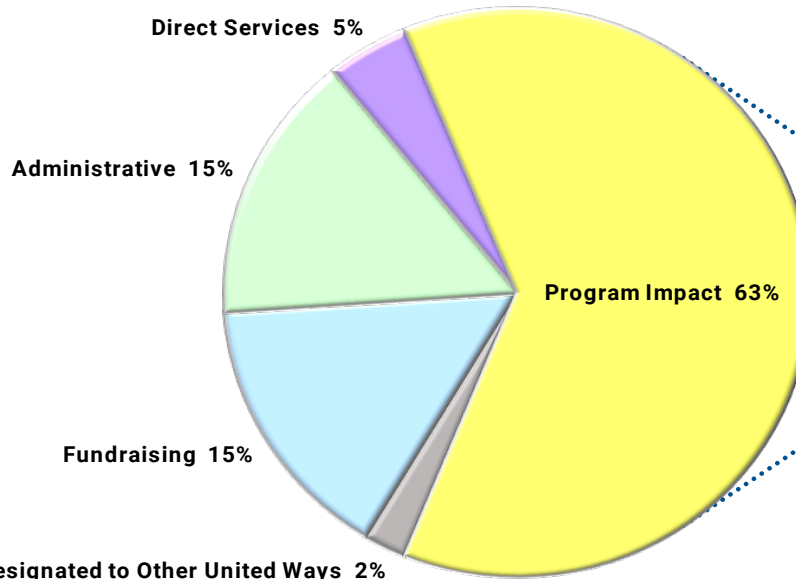

Emergency Services Fund

In anticipation of the affect the COVID-19 pandemic would likely have on St. Clair County residents, service organizations, and businesses, our Board set aside \$100,000 for COVID-19 relief grants. It is to be transferred from our reserves into our Emergency Services Fund as the need arises. As of the end of our fiscal year, Meijer, Inc. and Community Foundation for Southeast Michigan contributed \$26,000 and \$10,000, respectively, to our Emergency Services Fund to boost our relief efforts. Also as of that date, the grant application process, through the CRC, was open for any organization or business who needed help with unforeseen expenses related to COVID-19.
